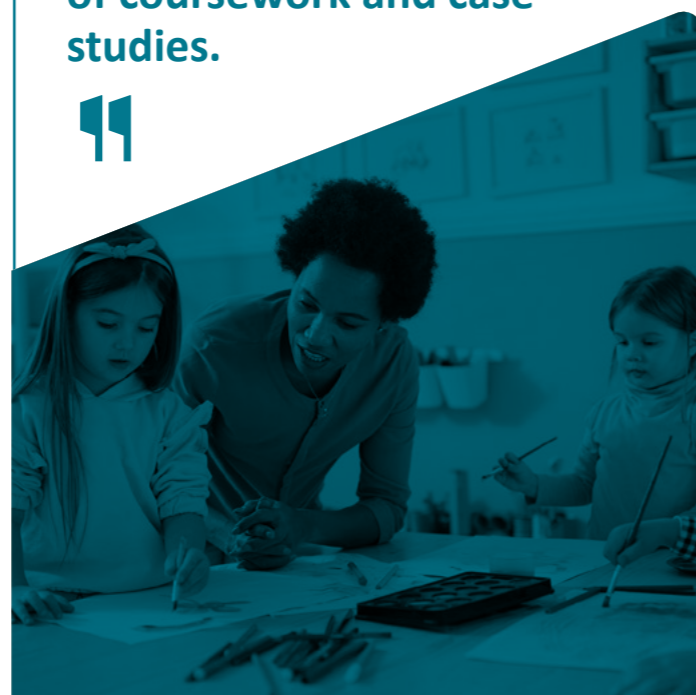

We'll assist you in securing a work placement to fulfill the course's requirements.

- Understanding SEN
- Working with others
- Maths and English (if required).

Work placement and DBS check

During the course, learners are required to demonstrate proficiency in both practical skills and theoretical knowledge. As such, you will complete a work placement in a school or early years setting to gain hands-on experience. Access Training will assist you to find a suitable placement and will cover the cost of a Disclosure and Barring Service (DBS) check, which is necessary for safeguarding purposes.

Access Training will fund DBS checks when needed to work with children.

Level 1 Certificate Customer Service

The Level 1 Certificate in Customer Service aims to equip you with the necessary skills and knowledge to provide quality customer service in any setting. Through this course, you will have the opportunity to learn, improve and apply your customer service skills.

Course Details

Location:	Nottingham city centre
Duration:	Three days a week including a work placement. The course will last one academic year and take place during term time only.
Teaching and assessments:	Case studies and coursework

You will cover the following topics:

- Legislation, regulation and procedures to follow in customer service
- Working in customer service
- Understand how to deal with queries and requests
- Communicate customer problems with others
- Handle telephone calls from customers
- Communicate effectively with customers
- Maths and English (if required).

You will attend classes for three days a week to study customer service theory, and maths and English (if required). During the course, you will also have the opportunity to attend a suitable work placement, depending upon your attitude and performance.

What careers can this course lead to?

This qualification is generic to any industry in customer service and could lead to the following jobs:

- Customer service employee
- Telephone call centre operator
- Retail or leisure centre customer contact.

Entry requirements are flexible although students are expected to be able to read and write.

- Introduction to health and safety in construction
- Introduction to the construction industry
- Fixing architraves and skirtings
- Constructing block walling
- Painting and wallpapering
- Applying decorative effects
- Painting a panelled door
- Tiling a plain wall
- Constructing a half brick wall
- Constructing half brick return corner
- Constructing one brick walling of six courses
- Laying block paving
- Maths and English (if required).

- Check that a small animal is healthy
- Maintain the safety of self and others in the workplace
- Maths and English (if required).

Age requirements

You must be under 19 on 31 August and not in full-time education.

Entry requirements

Entry requirements are flexible although students are expected to be able to read and write.

Can I apply if I have an EHCP plan?

We would assess your application to ensure we can meet your level of requirements.

Where are the courses delivered?

All lessons are delivered face-to-face at our training facility in Nottingham City Centre.

Most of the full-time courses last one academic year and take place during term time only.

When do I enrol?

Courses begin in September.

Do I get paid?

No, but bursary support may be available.

Am I entitled to any other financial support?

You may be entitled to a bursary of £1,200 if you complete 30 weeks of study in one year.

Are these courses free?

Yes, you will not be expected to pay for the course.

Can I be in full-time employment at the same time?

No, but you will be able to have a part-time job as long as it doesn't interfere with your study or work placement timetable.

What options are available to me after completion?

Opportunities may be available to progress to an apprenticeship. We will be able to assist in matching you with a suitable employer.
